### Laurel Smith-Raul LMSW- Enoch Pratt Library

- The Pratt now has 1 Social Worker and 6 interns that are working with the individual libraries.
- As libraries are a hub of the community, The Pratt will be asset mapping.
- The community will be involved in developing the map.
- Because we already have a map, the map will just be reviewed and possibly published on The Pratt's website.
- Laurel will come to the next YRP meeting (Feb 6) with a large map so that we can review and provide input.

### Dollar Tree

- Proposal was brought to Winston Govans and Radnor Winston because what Dollar Tree was proposing does not meet zoning requirements
- Wants to also buy the church next door to the south to create a parking lot
- Because the trucks can only be loaded from the York Road side of the building, the storage will be in the York Road side of the building. Entrance will be on the side street. This does not meet the cities 50% visibility into the building zoning code.
- Radnor Winston sent a letter saying that Dollar Tree needs to work within the zoning requirements

#### Ad Hoc Liquor

- Noir now open next to Toss- MOU is attached to liquor license
