Minutes**

President Chris Forrest called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. There were 46 participants on Zoom.

1. Councilman Mark Conway reported out on his legislative work this past year and priorities for 2022.
2. Karen DeCamp and Sandi McFadden reported on the 1/4/22 BMZA written decision to approve the Vaughn Greene crematorium, which means YRP has 30 days to file a notice of intent to appeal at Circuit Court. The membership was asked to vote on the following:

PLEASE VOTE YES OR NO: Regarding the Vaughn Greene proposal for a Human Crematorium at its 4905 York Road location that has been approved by the BMZA (Board of Municipal Zoning Appeals). To authorize YRP to apply for representation by Community Law Center to oppose the MD Dept of the Environment air pollution permit and to appeal the BMZA decision approving the human crematorium in Circuit Court

3. **Marjorie Lane Apartments -Proposed Treatment Center:** Frank Wolkenberg [fwolkenberg@gmail.com](mailto:fwolkenberg@gmail.com) reported on the Evsham Park neighborhood's opposition to the proposed residential drug treatment facility in the 9 unit Marjorie Lane Apartments. The developer has no experience in this type of facility and proposes putting 36 residents with only one staffperson on site.
